In view of shifting of Darbar to Jammu, it has been observed in past that most of the HoDs leave their offices and proceed to Jammu without proper permission from Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir, resultantly the general public is put to hardships especially with the onset of winters. Moreover, the Deputy Commissioners are also impressed upon to attend to public grievances on day-to-day basis, Stock position of essential commodities, snow clearances and other issues shall be brought to the notice of undersigned immediately, besides constituting squads for ensuing attendance in the offices in their respective jurisdictions.

Report on all these points together with important issues be submitted to the office of Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir on weekly basis.
