FORM 'C' (PERMIT UNDER SECTION 4)

Whereas, Abdul Rehman Draboo R/o Upper Soura Srinagar had applied on 26-04-2015 through prescribed application form for grant of permission for felling down of Nine (09) Deodar trees on the pretext that they were posing danger and nuisance to life and property, which was forwarded in original to the Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar for appropriate action in light of the Jammu and Kashmir Preservation of Specified Trees Act, 1969, who vide his letter No; 531/tree/15 dated:09-11-2015 recommended the case for further necessary action.

Whereas, the case was returned to Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar vide this office letter No: DivCom/TS-ARDF(1078)15/107 dated:29-01-2016 for verification of the Deodar trees under proposed felling through the Tehsildar concerned, besides fresh factual report/ comments were also sought from the Deputy Commissioner, who vide his letter No: 66/tree/16 dated:23-05-2016 reported that the Deodar trees in question have been planted by Ab Rehman Drabu which are very close to the residential house of Hafizullah Masoodi and has caused damage to compound wall and have developed cracks in the Varandah of the house of Hafizullah Masoodi, but the case was again returned to Deputy Commissioner for his categoric recommendation, who vide his letter No: 173/tree/16 dated:19-11-2016 has re-submitted the case alongwith his recommendation.

Whereas, the neighbour of the applicant namely Hafizullah Masoodi S/o Bashir Ahmad Masoodi R/o Upper Soura Srinagar filed a writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court of J&K at Srinagar in OWP No. 2148/2017 MP No. 01/2017 for grant of permission for felling/cut down Nine (09) Deodar trees situated at Upper Soura Srinagar located near the residential house of the applicant in terms of Section 5, of Jammu and Kashmir Preservation of Specified Trees Act, 1969.

Whereas, the petitioner also prayed for payment of compensation in his favour as may be found adequate by the Hon'ble High Court to compensate mental pain, agony, stress and strain and resultant ailments suffered by the petitioner and his family members.

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court issued an order on 4-12-2019 with the direction that this office being prescribed authority under the Jammu and Kashmir Preservation of Specified Trees Act, 1969, and Rules made thereunder for allowing the respondent No. 3 to fell/cut down Nine (09) Deodar Trees close to the residential house of the petitioner situated at Upper Soura Srinagar.

Whereas, the matter was taken up with the Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar vide this office letter No; DivCom/RA-HVS/98/2019 dated:07-01-2020 for his report along with explicit recommendation, and copy also to D.F.O Urban Forestry Srinagar for similar necessary action.

Whereas, the Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar vide his letter No; DCS/ARA/(970)/2020/1497 dated:15-07-2020 reported that one Abdul Rehman Drabu has planted Deodar trees in his land falling under Survey Nos. 359 Min in estate Buchpora which are close to the residential house of Hafizullah Masoodi and had caused damage to the compound wall besides created cracks in footpath of the house of Hafizullah Masoodi, also the deodar trees in question are leaning toward the house of Hafizullah Masoodi causing threat to life and property. However the D.F.O Urban Forestry Divison Srinagar vide letter No: DFO/UFD/Lease/4608/L dated: 03-03-2020 has also recommened for extraction of these nine (09) Deodar trees as they pose threat to life and property.

Whereas the matter was again taken up with the Deputy Commissioner, Srinagar vide letter No: Divcom/RA-HVS/98/2020 dated:10-09-2020 for providing Jamabandi Arazi of the land in which the specified trees are situated along with a certificate from Tehsildar concerned certifying therein that the trees are desired to be felled for prevention of danger and abatement of nuisance to life and property, who vide his letter No: DCS/Deodar trees/20/387-88 dated:04-03-2021 furnished the same.

Therefore in the backdrop of above mentioned facts and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 5, of Jammu and Kashmir Preservation of Specified Trees Act, 1969, sanction hereby accorded to the grant of permission in favour of applicant/ respondent No.3 namely Abdul Rehman Draboo R/o Upper Soura Tehsil Eidgah District Srinagar to fell down Nine (09) Deodar trees standing very close to the residential house of the petitioner also identified on the enclosed photograph (Specified Trees) which are posing threat to life and property standing in Survey No.359 Min situated at Upper Soura Tehsil Eidgah District Srinagar.

This permission is issued subject to the following conditions:-

- i. That felling/lifting of a Deodar trees shall be conducted under the close supervision of the Tehsildar/Divisional Forest Officer concerned.
- ii. That the applicant shall not claim for lifting of said timber out side his locality.
- iii. The applicant shall not barter/sell the same timber and will utilize for bonafide use only.
- iv. That the permit will remain in force for a period of sixty (60) days only from the date of dispatch of this permit.
- v. That before felling/lifting of Deodar trees rightful owner(s) must be verified properly by the Tehsildar concerned.
- vi. The Concerned Revenue as well as Forest authorities shall be held responsible for any act on their part which goes contrary to their recommendations in the event of any complaint.
- vii. That no contravention of any act/rule takes place under the garb of this permit.
